

Notes from September 24, 2014 Waverly Community Board meeting:

Following Commissioner Gaiter's meeting, there were four WCB members which did not constitute a quorum. Discussion was as follows:

Of the 12 Board members, one has not attended any meetings since the November 2013 election, one has asked to have her name withdrawn, one has attended only one or two meetings since the November 2013 election and two people are attending a class that meets on the same night as the WCB meetings and will resume coming next spring. This leaves seven active members. Options for discussion at the Annual Meeting include restructuring and recruitment.

Pancake Breakfast debrief: A big thanks to the Wellington Fire Department Chief and Firemen for making the fire station an easier site than those in past years. Jan reported that between 75 and 100 people attended and donations were received in the amount of \$383.00 which was deposited. The treasury has a balance of \$618.31.
